EPQ'S, MOOCS, WEX, G&T, ENRICHMENTS & LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

EPQ - The Extended Project Qualification is an additional qualification students can take up alongside their studies, and is the equivalent of 1 AS level.

MOOC - Massive Open Online Course is an online course students can take in a variety of subject areas to bolster their end achievement. In addition to diversifying your educational portfolio and skill base, they also look great on UCAS statements and CVs.

WEX - Work Experience Programme is designed to help students find part-time employment or volunteer positions. Students on these courses benefit from extra employability skills, good references, as well as earning a small income!

G&T - Gifted & Talented is a government initiative to recognise, support and challenge the top percentage of achievers. Students who excel in a particular area can also be registered as G&T.

Enrichments are extra-curricular activities students can engage with to enhance their study programme. Enrichments are run by staff, external partners and other students. If you have a great idea for a new enrichment all you need to do is let your tutor know to get it started! We have a wide range of ever-changing enrichments including: Boxing, Football, Basketball, Creative Writing, Dance Club, Photography, Podcasting and many more.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 2** **Level 2** – 4 GCSEs grade 3 and above.
- 3** **Level 3** – 4 GCSEs grade 9 - 4

A-LEVEL

For all A-Level courses, 5 GCSEs at grade 9-4 are required. This includes both maths and English. Please see the A-Level section for more information.

INTERVIEW

The final entry requirement for all courses is a successful interview.

- 1** Be on time and be presentable, your first impression is important, make sure it's a good one.
- 2** Make sure to ask any questions that you may have. It may help if you write a list of questions before your interview so that you do not forget any.
- 3** It's okay to be nervous or anxious, just take your time and answer the questions when you're ready.

Shooters Hill Sixth Form College is here to support you in any way we can. If you feel like you need somebody to talk to or just listen, you can access our counselling services. This is a confidential service so you can trust that we will be discrete with your information.



THERAPY DOG

Findlay is our college therapy dog, in place to help students who are feeling upset or anxious. When he is not relaxing in his room, he can be found being walked around the college looking for students to help.

BURSARY

Students aged 16–19 who are in care, care leavers, claiming Income Support/Universal Credit in their own name, or claiming both ESA and DLA or a PIP in their own name, will be eligible for a bursary of up to £1,200 to support them during their studies. Those eligible for free school meals (from low income households and young carers) may also be able to access financial support via the college Discretionary Bursary fund.

Additional Learning Support

Learning Support offers extra assistance, help, advice and study support to those students whose particular needs affect their ability to study, and or make progress.

If you need extra help with your learning, specialist staff will work closely with you to assess your learning needs.

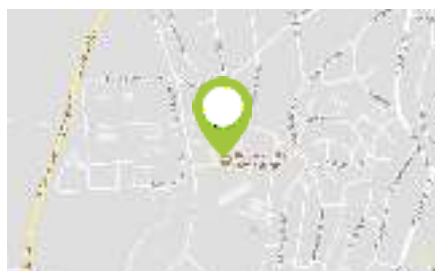
